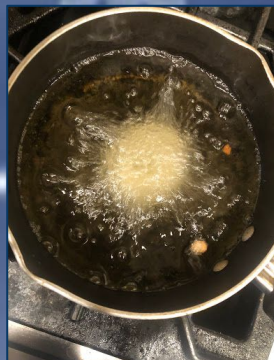

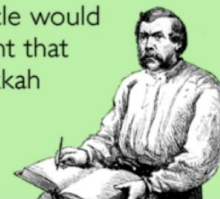

THERE ARE AT LEAST 44 CANDLES IN EACH BOX OF CHANUKAH CANDLES. THAT IS WHAT YOU NEED TO LIGHT THE MENORAH EVERY NIGHT.

CHANUKAH CAN BEGIN ON ANY DAY OF THE WEEK BESIDES TUESDAY.

THERE IS NO "WRONG" WAY TO SPELL CHANUKAH.. WHETHER YOU SPELL IT HANUKKAH, CHANUKAH, HANUKAH, DON'T WORRY ABOUT IT -- THEY'RE ALL RIGHT.

ISRAELIS CONSUME 24 MILLION SUFGANIYOT DURING THE EIGHT-DAY HOLIDAY. WITH THE AVERAGE SUFGANIYAH CONTAINING 400-600 CALORIES, THAT IS ABOUT 10.8 BILLION CALORIES.

GELT AS WE KNOW IT IS A RELATIVELY NEW TRADITION — AND NO ONE KNOWS WHO INVENTED IT.

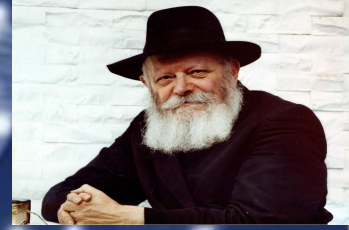

Rebbe Story



Chaim Tzvi Schwartz was a Munkatcher Chosid who the Rebbe told him live in Brazil and he had a school there. A few years after he went to Brazil, Rabbi Schwartz once met on a Chassid in a flight to New York and he told him a story: One day, I got a call from the parents of one of the children in my school, asking for a meeting. This was a common request, but he heard that parents were very stressed on the phone they told me that this was no simple matter. I invited them to meet with me in my home that evening.

"This is not about our son," began the father, "he is doing wonderfully in your school, but about our oldest daughter, who grew up here before you came. As you know, we are not very frum, but it is important to us that our children should remain as Jews. This is why we send our son to your school, despite the fact that your school is more Frum than we are.

"To get to the point, our daughter has told us that she met a non Jew, and that they want to marry. We have tried everything to make her change her mind but all our protests have all been no help. She now does not allow us to discuss the matter with her at all, and has moved out of our home. Rabbi! You are our only hope! Perhaps you can reach her; perhaps you can help her." "Would she agree to meet with me?" I asked.

"If she knew that we had spoken to you, she'd not allow it."

"Then I'll go speak to her on my own."

I took her address from her parents, and rang her bell that very evening. She was annoyed to learn of my mission, but too well mannered not to invite me in. We ended up speaking for several hours. She listened politely, and promised to consider everything I said, but I had the feeling that I had very little effect on her decision.

For a couple of days I thought about the matter, trying to think of what might possibly be done to stop her from marrying this non Jew. Then I thought of my last option the Rebbe. 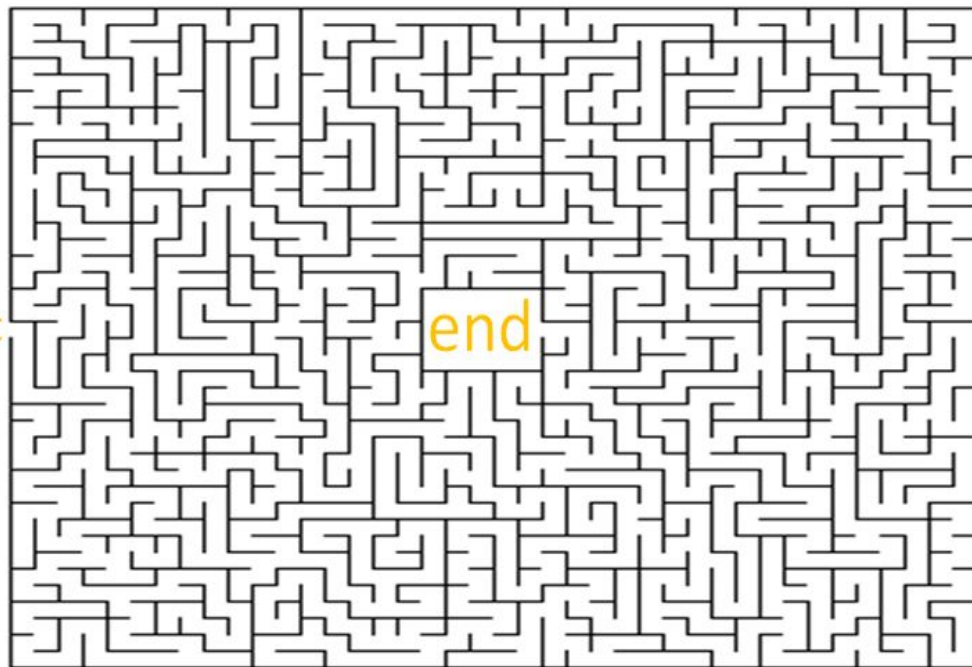
