Polymer Charms



Roll a ball of light brown/cream colored polymer clay.



Place on top of doughnut



Add any decorations you would like



Flatten it a little



Poke hole again through icing



If you want it to be a charm, you can add an eye-pin. Then bake according to packages instructions, and Voila!



Poke a hole down the middle with a toothpick



Make 2 indents for eyes



Take a piece of colored polymer clay and roll it out



Put in the eyes



Cut out a circle or flower shape for icing



Roll tiny coil of polymer clay and shape in to a U for the mouth.
