## Pinwheel Cookies

1-1/2 cups flour

1/2 tsp baking powder

1/4 tsp table salt

1/2 cup oil

3/4 cup sugar

1 egg

1 tsp pure vanilla extract

2 tbsp cocoa powder

2 oz chocolate chips,  
melted





## *Directions:*

*Mix the sugar, vanilla extract oil and eggs, Then add the flour, baking powder, salt, mix them all together*

*Separate the dough into bowls*

*Then melt the chocolate chips and coco and add them into one of the bowls*

*Roll out the doughs separately and then put one on top of the other, roll the dough into a line then cut them into pieces,*

*Preheat the oven to 350 and bake them for about 15 minutes! Enjoy!*
