# Slime!!

## Slime #2

You will need:

Elmers glue

Tide detergent

Bowl

Spoon (something to mix with)

Shaving cream (optional)

### Instructions:

1. Add some glue to your mixing bowl
2. If you prefer a fluffier slime, add shaving cream
3. Add Tide detergent into bowl with glue
4. Mix ingredients together with spoon until your slime feels and looks how you want it

## Slime #1

You will need:

Elmers glue

Borax

Water

Bowl

Spoon (something to mix with)

Food coloring (optional)

Shaving cream (optional)

### Instructions:

1. Squeeze a bottle of glue (or as much as desired) into a bowl
2. Mix in 1 1/2 cups of warm water
3. Add food coloring, if desired
4. Mix 1 teaspoon of Borax into 1/2 cup of water, and slowly add the borax solution to the glue mixture
5. Stir in the Borax solution until the slime started to come together
6. If you prefer a fluffier slime, add shaving cream
