*in the summer i go away to sleepaway camp but our community stays the same b/c the weather is hot all year round and the main vacation for schools here is in December so most people stay*



*We have a Camp Gan Izzy and every day there are Jewish kids by our Chabad House. I like that some kids that live really far away (like a 2.5 hour drive) come to our camp and sleep over at my house. :) I like doing Shlichus by camp*
