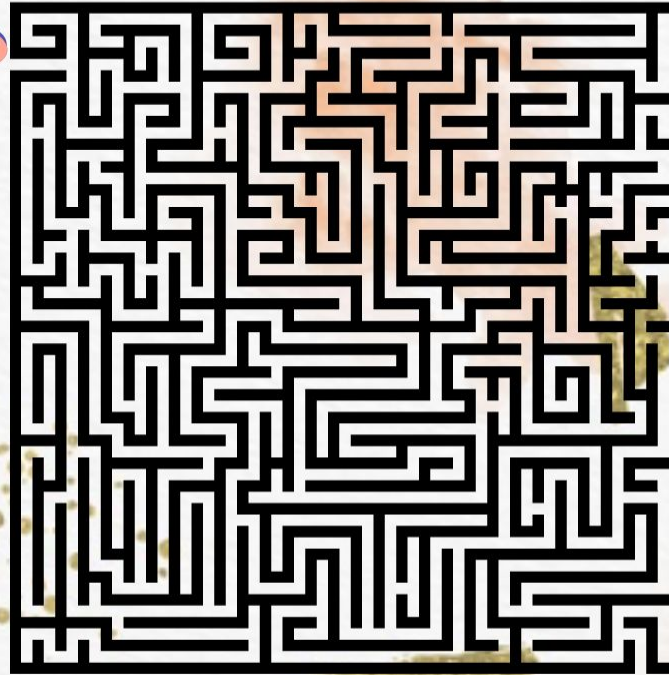

We had a very busy house, with lots of guests, people that had problems, or were sick. Our house was always lively, we were 11 siblings! My mother a"h was a great cook, and had a kind heart.

Wow! When did people start realizing the war was coming, and what were your feelings about it?

I was too young to understand war, or remember the feeling, which was generally tremendous fear.

Were the people on the farm you hid on kind to you because of the money given to them, or because they pitied you and didn't actually know who you were?

They were nice to me, I don't know if they pitied me. Of course, I didn't feel sorry for myself!

How long were you hiding for?

I can't really tell exact time, I was too young.

What was it like when you moved to Canada and had to learn new languages?

I didn't wear a coat in Montreal, and we went to a public school. The difficult part was, not only not knowing the language, but not knowing anyone. My Parents had a two bedroom house, which was also the Chabad House, and they had five kids ka"h. They knew they needed to find a new house. One house they found was a big house, a bit big for them, but good nonetheless. When they went to check it out, my Father loved it at once, but my Mother didn't, because it had smoke stains all over, and peeling paint, ect... Also, it was a lot over their budget.

Every month, my parents wrote a Duch about their Shlichus. After checking out the house, they opened an Igros, to read the letters on that page. To their surprise, the first letter said "Mazel Tov on your new house, you should move in right away, and put up the Mezuzos after 30 days." my Parents knew this was a sign that should get the house. They still had a problem, the house was way over their budget. Many miracles happened, like the owners lowered the price for my Parents, even though others were offering more; and someone offer to pay for some of it, ect... After a some time, with the help of Hashem, and The Rebbe's Bracha, the house was theirs, and we are still living in that house.
