

I was too young to understand war, or remember the feeling, which was generally tremendous fear.

Were the people on the farm you hid on kind to you because of the money given to them, or because they pitied you and didn't actually know who you were?

They were nice to me, I don't know if they pitied me. Of course, I didn't feel sorry for myself!

How long were you hiding for?

I can't really tell exact time, I was too young.

What was it like when you moved to Canada and had to learn new languages?

I didn't wear a coat in Montreal, and we went to a public school. The difficult part was, not only not knowing the language, but not knowing anyone.
